DUAL ENROLLMENT

DE is a state-funded program that allows 11th and 12th graders to take college classes while completing their high school diploma.

DE also provides limited options for 10th graders

DE pays for 100% tuition, mandatory fees, and required textbooks up to 30 college semester hours

Any 10th grader can take CTAE classes at a Technical College (e.g., Chattahoochee Tech)

10th graders who have earned a 1200 SAT or 26 ACT (in one sitting) are eligible to apply to any DE program



Today, you will be creating or updating your IGP, predicting what core courses to take next school year. Each student's plan will look different.



TOP STATE FOR TALENT ACT: CREATING YOUR GAFUTURES ACCOUNT





- GA passed the Top State for Talent Act (HB192) which requires students in 9th grade to create a GAfutures account at GAfutures.org.
- This initiative supports GEORGIA MATCH, a comprehensive direct admission program.
- Students can check their HOPE GPA through their GAfutures account to see if they are on track to be eligible for the HOPE or Zell Miller Scholarship.


