UGA has requested that all Georgia applicants submit their GAfutures transcript. If you are applying to UGA, your counselor will take care of sending both your Common App school report and transcript, as well as your GAfutures transcript when you request and pay for your transcript in the records room. Cobb County School District has disabled the option for students to request and send their own transcripts through GAfutures.

When you see this question on the Common App for UGA, select **Yes**. You do **NOT** need to self-report your grades.

Students graduating from a public or private high school in Georgia are *strongly encouraged* to send transcripts through GAfutures. This saves you time, reduces the risk of self-reporting errors, and supports a more efficient application review process. Sign into [your GAfutures account](#), click "My High School Transcript" on the left bar, and send a transcript to the University of Georgia before submitting this application.
