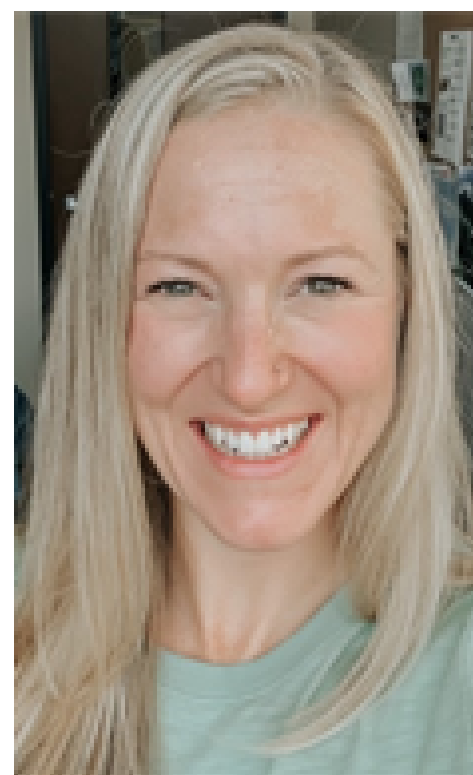

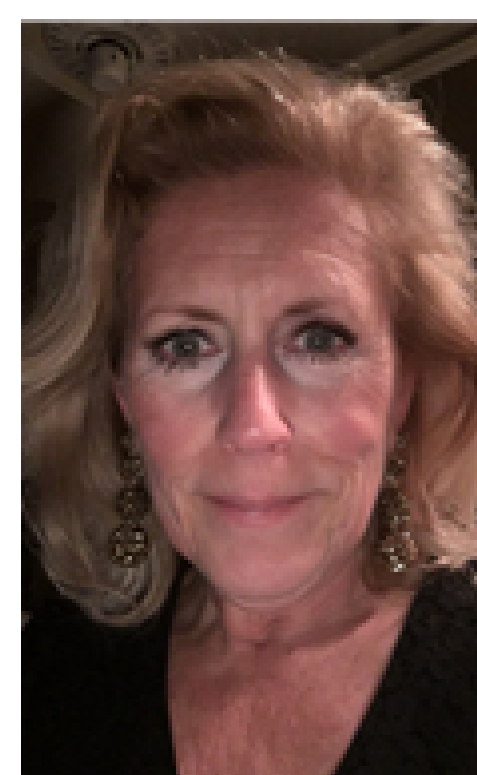

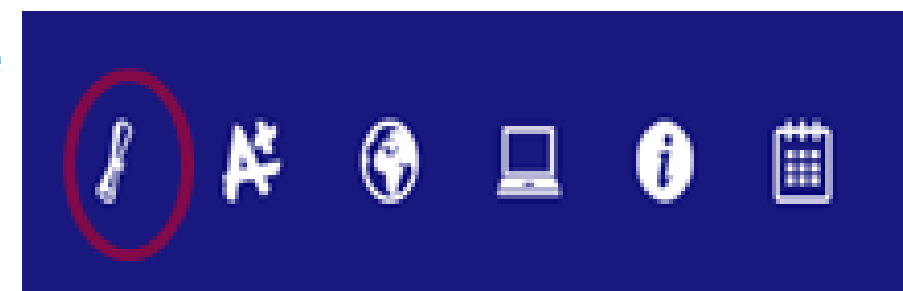
- Naviance is a delivery system and college/career search engine. We use it to communicate with you and we will use it throughout the year for various activities.

# How can you talk with your counselor?



- You can stop in during your lunch to speak with your counselor. No appointment is needed.
- If your counselor is busy (i.e. with another student, on the phone, has the door closed, etc.) please come back later in your lunch period or another day during your lunch or send your counselor an email.

# Things to know...



- Safety
  - No harassment & bullying policy
  - Tell an adult (teacher, counselor, assistant principal) if you're being harassed/bullied or know of others
- Crisis
  - A life-threatening situation
  - Tell an adult immediately
- Confidentiality
  - Danger to self or others



# Earning Credits



- Each class passed earns  $\frac{1}{2}$  (0.5) unit of credit
  - (3.0 units per semester/ 6.0 units per year)
- Promotion/Retention Rule:
  - 5 units for SOPHOMORE class
    - Must include full year 9th English, Math, & Science
  - 10 units for JUNIOR class
    - Must include full year 10th English, Math, & Science
  - 16 units for SENIOR class
- Need total of 23 units to graduate



- 90–100 = A (4.0)
- 80–89 = B (3.0)
- 74–79 = C (2.0)
- 70–73 = D (1.0)
- 0–69 = F (0.0)

- Total points divided by number of classes = GPA
- Honors classes receive half a quality point and AP classes receive a full quality point.

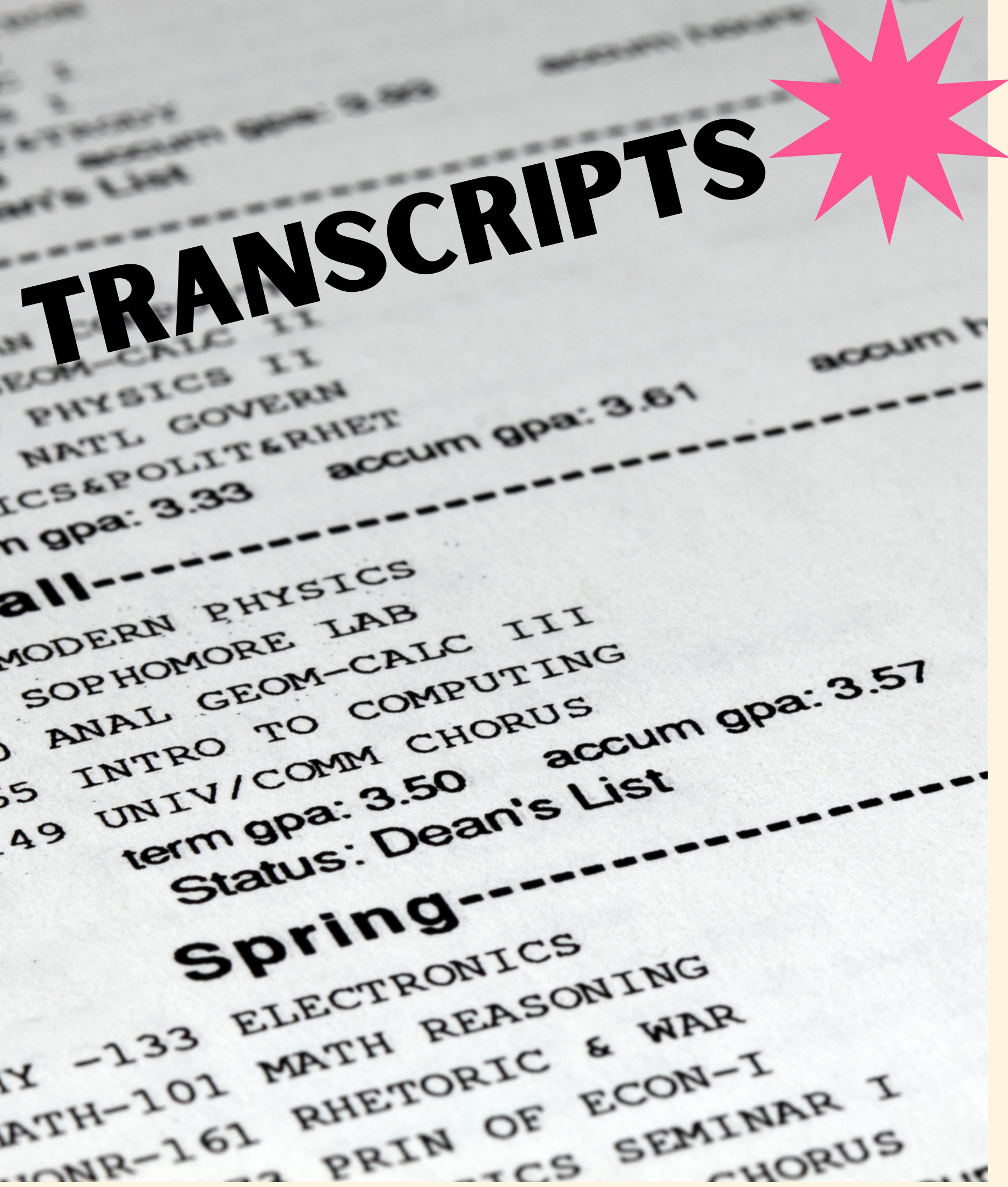
# Tips for Success

- Speak up if you start to struggle!
- Use resources: teachers, honor society tutors
- Use WEB days wisely!!!

- Study nightly and stay focused
- It's important to keep up with homework every night.
  - Review class notes
  - Read ahead or reread







- First Semester
  - September, November—progress reports
  - December 2022– Final Grade on Transcript
- Second Semester
  - February, April—progress reports
  - May 2023 – Final Grade on Transcript

**\*If you fail a class, you must make up that credit.**

**\*If you retake a class, your original failing grade still stays on your transcript.**

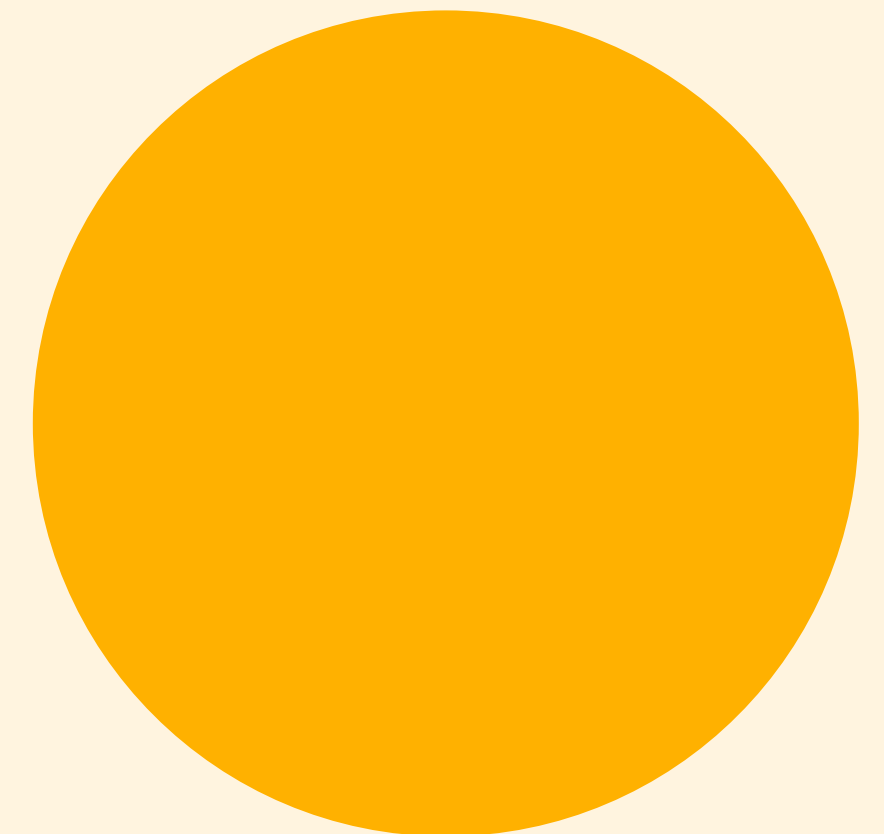
- 9th
  - 2.5 for spring eligibility (Pass 5 out of 6 Classes)
- 10th: 5.0 credits
  - Must include 2.5 from the previous semester
- 11th: 11 credits
  - Must include 2.5 from the previous semester
- 12th: 17 credits
  - Must include 2.5 from the previous semester





# Spring Semester Schedules

- Drop/add semester electives
  - mid-October
- Core classes – change of level request to teacher
- Waivers
- Deadlines!



# Schedule Change Policies

- The student does not meet prerequisite(s) for the course.
- The student does not meet the grade placement requirement for the course.
- The student already has credit for the course.
- The student is placed in an inappropriate level.




You cannot change levels past the waiver deadline and you cannot choose to change electives once school starts.





# Registration for 10th grade

- In February...
- You will select all courses for next year
- Parent/Guardian input is required/recommended—discuss teachers' recommendations with family
- Teachers are hired based on students' registrations
- Schedules are finalized by last day of school



You cannot change levels past the waiver deadline and you cannot choose to change electives once school starts.
